If you receive Consequences twice, your parents will be called.

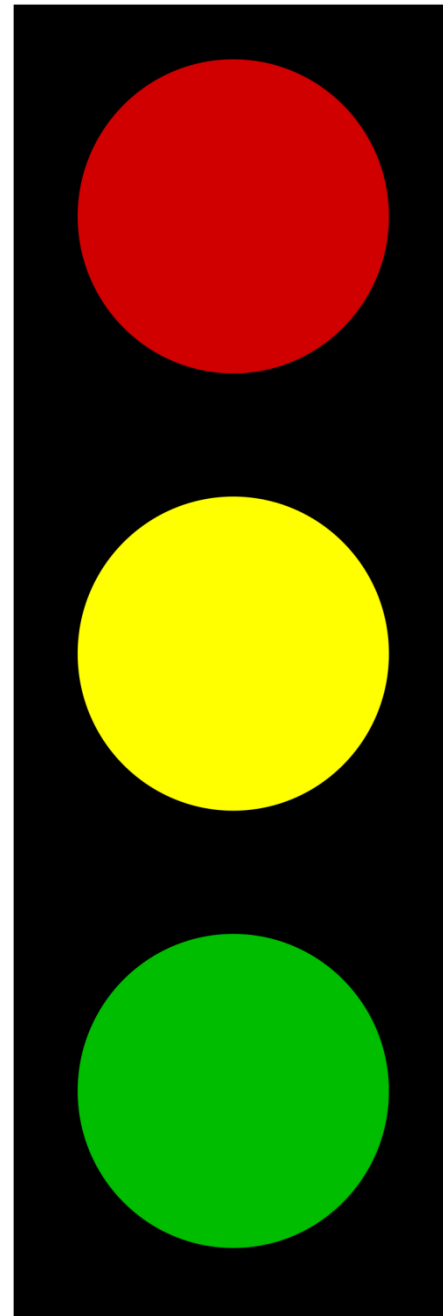
Further poor behaviour
You will move to Red.
Consequence= Time out

Remember- you can work hard to improve your behaviour and move **back to Green**

Further poor behaviour
You will move to Amber.
This means: warning/ think about it!

Poor behaviour
Teachers will give a warning and talk about how you could improve your behaviour

Everyone starts on
Green



Some classes use these symbols instead of traffic lights- they mean the same

Good behaviour



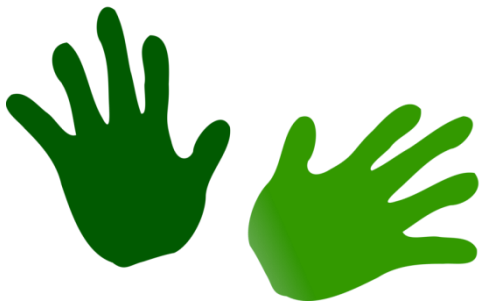

Heron #1 Rule

Keep your hands and feet to yourself!

If this rule is broken, you will immediately **move to Red**

Your parents will be called



Poor Behaviour at Break Time or Lunch Time

You will be given opportunities to improve your behaviour through things such as:

- Talking with the teacher
- Walking with the teacher
- Having calm down time



If your behaviour improves, you will be allowed to return play

Poor Behaviour at Break Time or Lunch Time

What happens if my behaviour does not improve?

- You will be brought into school to a teacher
- Your class teacher will be told by the MDSA
- You will move to Red



If the hands and feet rule is broken you will **move to Red**, have Time Out and your parents informed
