The successful candidate will be supporting pupils in KS1, working with pupils in the class and in small groups. Experience of working in a primary school setting is preferable although not essential. Applicants should be able to demonstrate a positive and sensitive approach that puts the needs of the child first, strong interpersonal skills, ability to show initiative and a clear understanding of the ways in which children learn successfully. An ability to show experience of behaviour modelling and behaviour management strategies would also be an advantage.

The TA position will be for 25.5 hours per week which will be worked as follows:

Mon - Thurs: 8.30am – 12.00 & 1.00pm – 3pm

Friday: 8.30am – 12.00pm

You will also be required to support with 0.5 hours lunchtime duty per day as follows:

Mon – Fri 12noon – 12.30pm
