The successful candidate will be supporting a pupil in KS2, working in class and in small groups where necessary. Experience of working in a primary school setting is preferable although not essential. However, applicants should be able to demonstrate a positive and sensitive approach that puts the needs of the child first, strong interpersonal skills, ability to show initiative and a clear understanding of the ways in which children learn successfully. Experience of behaviour modelling and behaviour management strategies would also be an advantage.

The TA position will be paid on Grade 5 (points 11-14) and will be for 17.5 hours per week. This will be worked as follows: Mon - Fri: 9.00am – 12.30pm

You will also be required to be a member of our OPAL Play Team with 0.5 hour lunchtime duty per day between 12.30pm - 1pm. This will be paid on Grade 2 (point 2-3).
